



Health and Safety Policy

The Board of Trustees is accountable for ensuring that students, staff and all visitors to the school shall have a safe physical and emotional environment.

(a) The Management Team is responsible for:

- Taking reasonable steps to protect students, staff and visitors from unsafe or unhealthy conditions
- Providing a smoke free environment
- Providing privacy of personal documentation held on the premises.
- Ensuring a risk analysis management system (RAMS) is carried out where and when appropriate in the School
- Advising the Board Chair of any emergency situations as soon as possible
- Ensuring compliance with the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 and the Vulnerable Children's Act 2014.

In addition,

(b) The Management Team shall:

- Consult with the community, where appropriate, regarding the sex education health programme being delivered to students at the School¹.

All staff, members of the Board and the school community are informed of this policy and consulted with prior to any changes.
