Curriculum policy

The Board is accountable for ensuring that:-

1. Teaching programmes are developed and documented based on the Dunedin Steiner School Curriculum, which reflects the Special Character of Steiner education.
2. The New Zealand Curriculum objectives are met in a way that is consistent with the Steiner Curriculum aims.
3. Aotearoa Hītori (New Zealand's histories) are embedded into the Steiner Curriculum
4. Teaching programmes meet students' needs at all levels.
5. The Curriculum Planning engages with the National Education and Learning Priorities (NELP)
6. The school creates and follows a three yearly cycle of internal evaluation, which includes ongoing monitoring, achieving objective reflection and review of all relevant aspects of school life.

The Principal is responsible for ensuring the above are in place and that teaching staff are consulted with on any changes to curriculum practice. The school parent community is informed of this policy through the Parent Handbook.
