Settling Procedure

It is our policy to admit children gradually into the Kindergarten environment.

The child will visit the Kindergarten accompanied by a parent/guardian two or three times, until s/he seems secure and the teacher has established a basic relationship with child and parent/guardian.

Sometime after admission the teacher may visit the child's home, if invited. This enables the child to interact with the teacher on 'home ground'. It gives the teacher an opportunity to build reciprocal relationships that s/he will gain a deeper understanding of the child's background and history. The teacher and parents build a comfortable and positive relationship benefitting the child and establishing communication enhancing the child's wellbeing.
